The next business was to propose that the officers remain in post for the next term 2020-21. The Phil Mountford proposed, and the WM seconded the proposition which was unanimously carried.

In any other business, Phil Mountford urged the brethren to consider making the most of the monies in the charity account. The ELMC was favourite bearing in mind the 2022 Festival would soon be upon us.

The WM passed on the congratulations of the Lodge to Richard Sykes on achieving London Grand Rank.

Richard thanked the Lodge and mentioned that Chris Lomax had at least 2, possibly 3 candidates primed when we eventually get back to normal.

George Johnson advised us that there will be a virtual Charity Stewards meeting next week and he will report back in due course.

Our next virtual meeting (depending on lockdown restrictions remaining in place) will be on the 7th October where Stuart Browning will endeavour to get everyone together on Zoom.
